# WHERE WILL YOU SPEND ETERNITY?



The most important question in life is, **“Where will you spend eternity?”** Yet most people put off thinking about it because they believe they are just too young or too busy or too old, or too ... whatever. They may even try to convince themselves (and others) there is nothing after death.

But in our hearts we know eternity is there.<sup>1</sup> Moreover, the Bible reminds us, “It is appointed for every man and woman to die once, but after this the judgment.”<sup>2</sup>

**Will you go to Heaven when you die?** Here’s a quick test. Have you ever told a lie, stolen anything or used God’s name in vain? Acted immorally? Jesus said, “Whoever even looks at a woman or man lustfully has already committed adultery (sex) in their heart with that person.”<sup>3</sup> Have you looked with lust? Will you be guilty on Judgment Day? If you have done those things, God sees you as a lying, thieving, blasphemous, adulterer at heart. And these are only 4 of the 10 Commandments.<sup>4</sup>



Many people will almost cheerfully admit to being sinners, because they have no idea what this means. They treat it as being ‘just human nature’ or they shelter behind the fact that ‘everybody does it’ and believe they are basically a ‘Good Person’.

But those statements dodge the real issue of how serious sin is to a Holy God, and that no one is good.<sup>5</sup>

**The Bible warns that if you sin you will end up in Hell.**<sup>6</sup>

Does this worry you? It should. But did you know God loves you so much that He “...gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.”<sup>7</sup> He then rose from the dead and defeated death. Not convinced? *Think about it:*

- *Archaeological discoveries continue to verify the Bible’s historical accuracy.*
- *The historical data about Jesus supports his life, death and resurrection.*
- *Jesus fulfils dozens of incredibly detailed prophecies, some written over 700 hundred years before he was born.*



**Think also about what the Bible says of how Jesus humbled himself and became nothing, even to the point of dying on the cross, so God could forgive your sins and grant you the gift of eternal life. It is written: “If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”<sup>8</sup>**
